The following are some of the services that the GCSA supply to the Gemfields Community.

Meals on Wheels— “We are more than just a meal” A hot, or ready-to-heat subsidised meal is delivered at low cost to those who would otherwise be nutritionally at risk, including the frail aged and people with disabilities.

Social Support— A friendly visiting service provides outreach support for the aged, ill, housebound and those with disabilities.

Personal Care— Personal Care services provide assistance at home with daily living for the frail aged, the ill and those with disabilities to help with showering, grooming, dressing and general hygiene.

Respite Care— Provides respite care of the frail elderly and those with disabilities in order to allow their families or carers free time. Planned regular respite, emergency respite or occasional respite can be provided in the clients' homes or on outings.

Domestic Assistance—Home Care services are available for frail elderly, incapacitated or ill residents and those with disabilities to help with household duties including cleaning, laundry, meal preparation and shopping.

Our aim is to help the elderly, incapacitated or those with a disability to remain independent in their own homes without being prematurely forced into an aged care or other facility.

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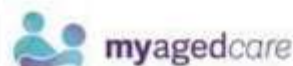

Pain

It probably won't surprise you, but pain in its many forms is one of the most frequent problems we're called to. In the Gemfields, roughly:

- 10% of our workload is for abdominal pain
- 5% back pain
- 25% chest pain of various causes
- 2% headaches

as well as pain associated with a lot of other presentations too.

Managing pain, both chronic and acute, can be challenging. When should you consider calling triple zero for pain? As always, if you have any doubt about whether you need attention or not, give us a call on triple zero (000). Specifically, for different types of pain:

- **Chest pain** – If you are experiencing unusual chest pain, that you can't explain, and particularly if you have other symptoms as well (such as shortness of breath, dizziness, clamminess, nausea etc) ALWAYS call triple zero (000). If in doubt, call.
- **Abdominal pain** – again, if you are experiencing moderate to severe and/or persistent abdominal pain that you can't explain, we'd strongly recommend calling us on triple zero (000). The issue with abdominal pain is that, while quite often abdo pain is caused by something fairly benign, 1) there are a lot of different organs and other structures packed into your abdomen and groin, some of which can cause dangers if they rupture, become infected etc, and 2) diagnosing abdominal pain can be challenging and often requires hospital assessment.
- **Headaches** – we've all experienced headaches, and certainly the vast majority of the time you will not need to call the ambulance or see a doctor for these headaches. You generally know what your triggers are for mild to moderate headaches, and what helps to relieve them (e.g. over the counter analgesia, drinking more water, rest etc). However, again if in doubt, call us on triple zero, particularly if there are any risk factors such as recent head trauma, history of stroke, you're on "blood thinner" drugs, pregnancy, you're also experiencing a rash, loss of consciousness, altered sensation, confusion, seizures, the elderly or young children, or you're experiencing worsening headaches. Again, if you're not sure, call us on Triple Zero (000).
- **Back pain** – Similar to headaches, I think most of us have experienced back pain at one stage or another, and again, we often know what the triggers and fixes are for these aches and pains. For routine back aches, the ambulance is usually not required, but if it's much worse than normal, you can't walk, you've got altered sensation in some or all limbs etc, or you've got back pain after a fall or other trauma, certainly call us on triple zero.
- **Sprains and strains** – It is often not necessary to call the ambulance for minor sprains and strains. If you're confident the issue is minor, try some over-the-counter pain medication, and applying Rest, Ice (wrapped in a tea-towel), Compression and Elevation (RICE). However, if you're not sure about the seriousness of a sprain/strain, the pain does not improve over time, or you suspect there could be a broken bone, call us on triple zero (000) or consider visiting your GP. Certainly seek help with a limb injury if there's deformity, too much swelling, discolouration, altered sensation, or there's reduced function in the limb (can't move it, can't grip, can't walk).

We will be interested in your feedback and suggestions for improvement and other items we could cover. Don't be shy, we don't bite.

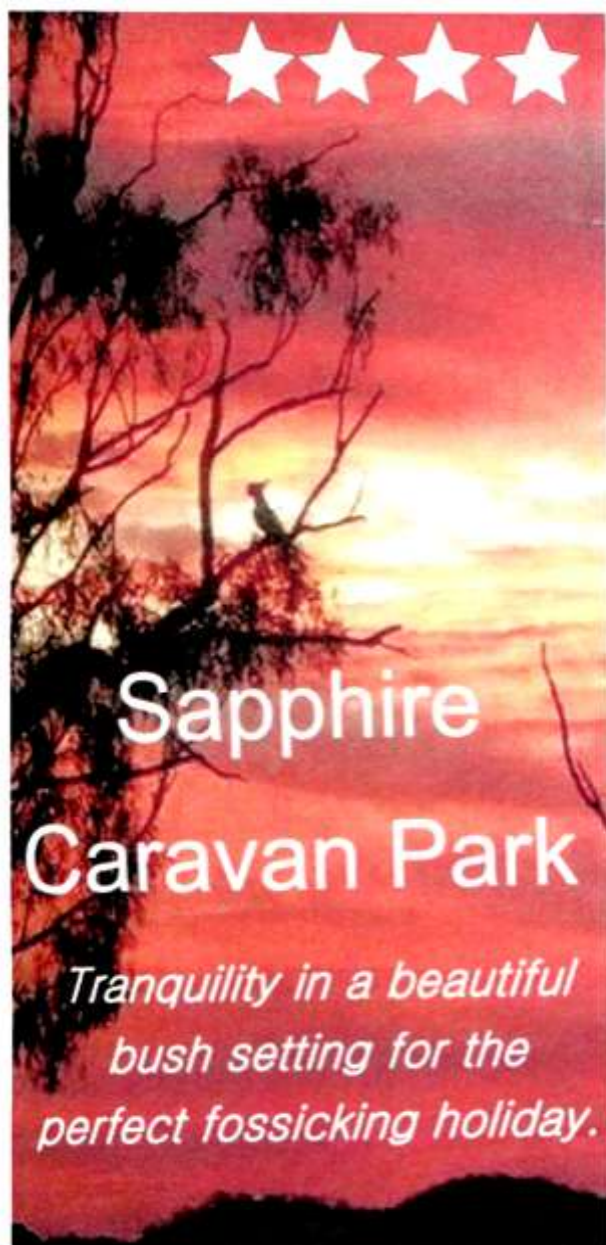

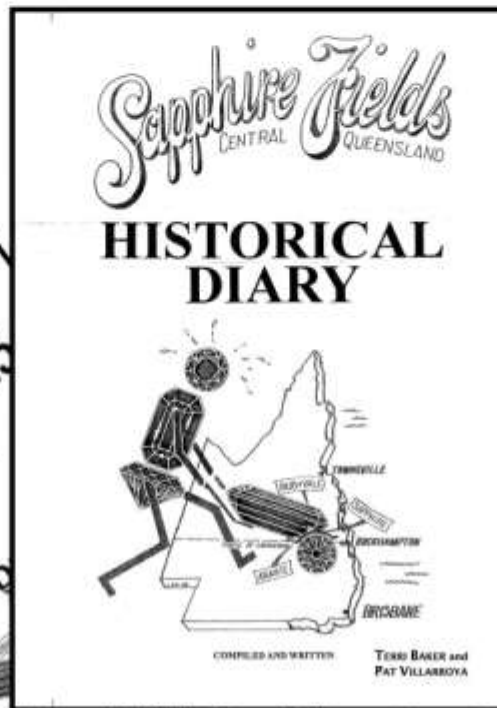

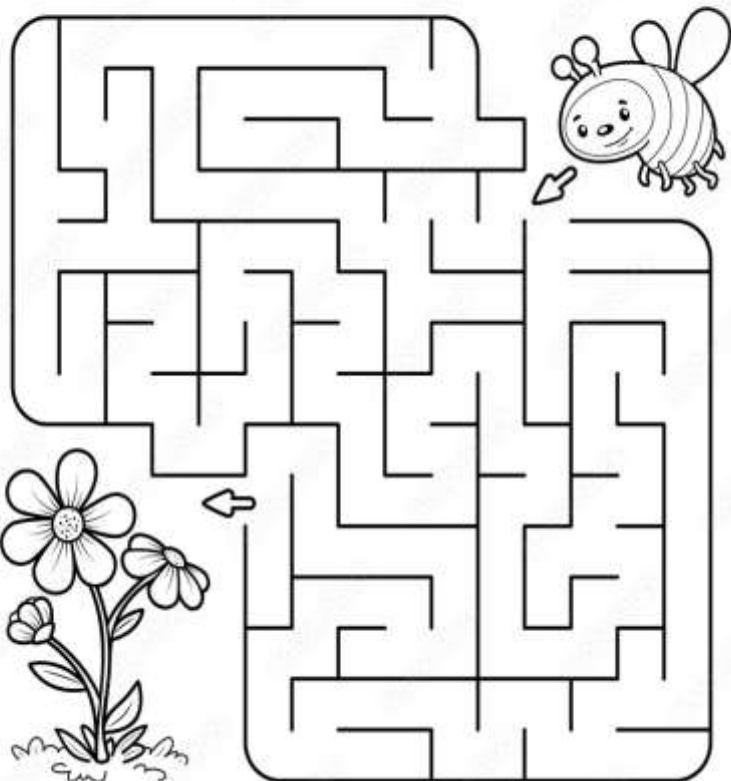

CREAMY MUSTARD CHICKEN TRAY BAKE

Ingredients

- 600g Skinless Chicken Breast
- 4 Shallots halved
- 2 Garlic cloves minced
- 1 Bunch baby carrots peeled & halved lengthways
- 200ml Carton light sour cream
- 2tsp Dijon mustard
- 1 Chicken stock cube
- 125g Green beans
- 1tbsp Fresh thyme
- 600g Potatoes with skin approx. 150g each
- 1 Bunch of Broccolini
- Olive oil spray



Method

- Preheat oven to 180C
- Prick the potatoes and microwave for 10min, then place on small baking dish, spray with oil and sprinkle with salt. Place in Oven
- After 10min place chicken in another baking dish with shallots and carrots. Spray with olive oil and roast for 20min.
- Dissolve stock cube in 1tbsp of hot water and allow to cool.
- Whisk together the sour cream, garlic, mustard and stock in a jug. Add the beans to the chicken and pour the sauce into the baking dish
- Bake for a further 10-15min until chicken is fully cooked and potatoes golden brown.
- Steam the broccolini
- Sprinkle the chicken dish with chopped thyme. Serve alongside the baked potatoes and broccolini. (Serves 4)

RASPBERRY JAM COCONUT SLICE

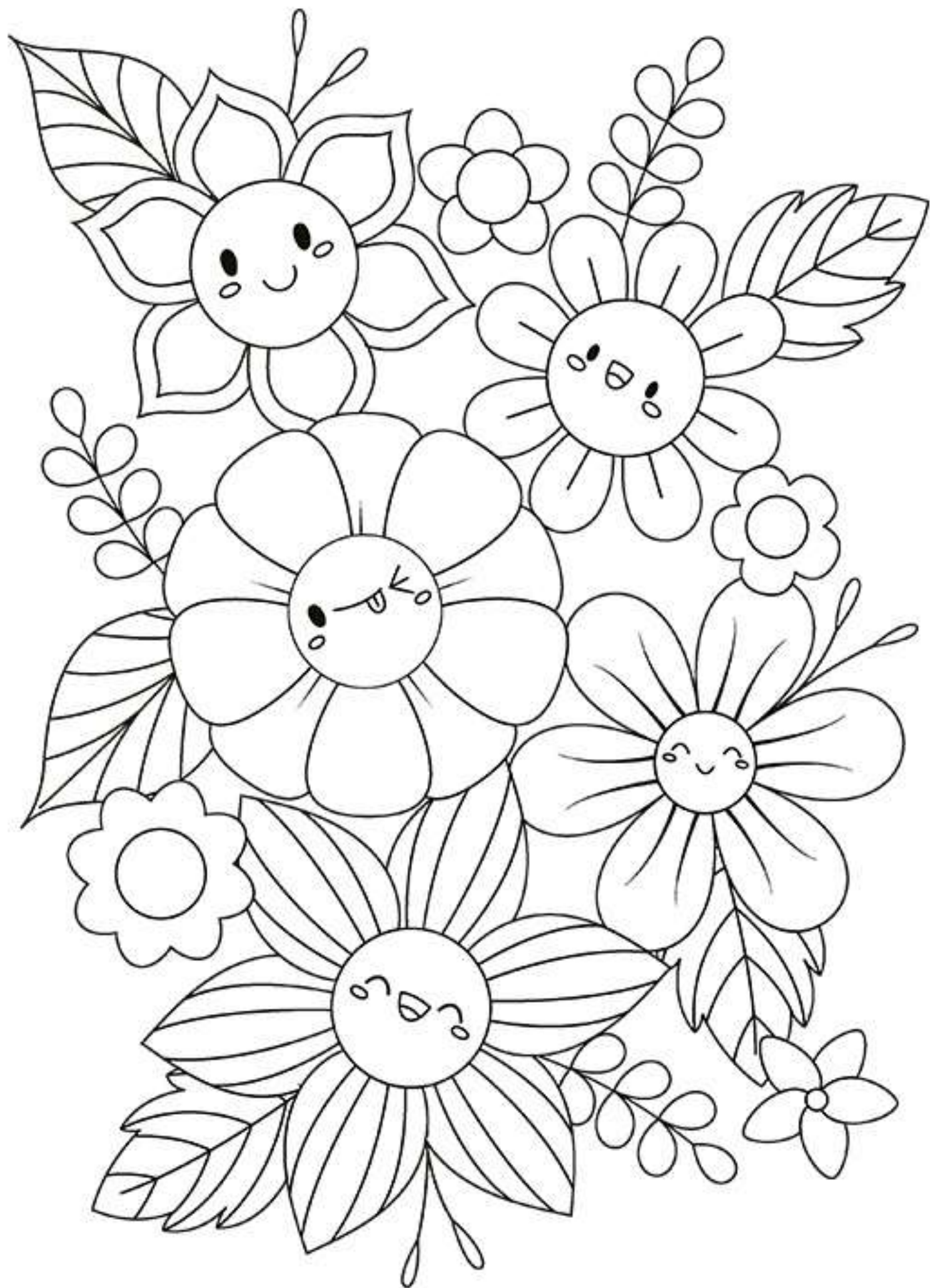
Ingredients

- 2 cups plain flour
- 1 cup caster sugar
- 125g butter, unsalted, chilled, cubed
- 1tsp vanilla essence
- 3 eggs
- 3/4 cup raspberry jam
- 2 cups desiccated coconut



Method

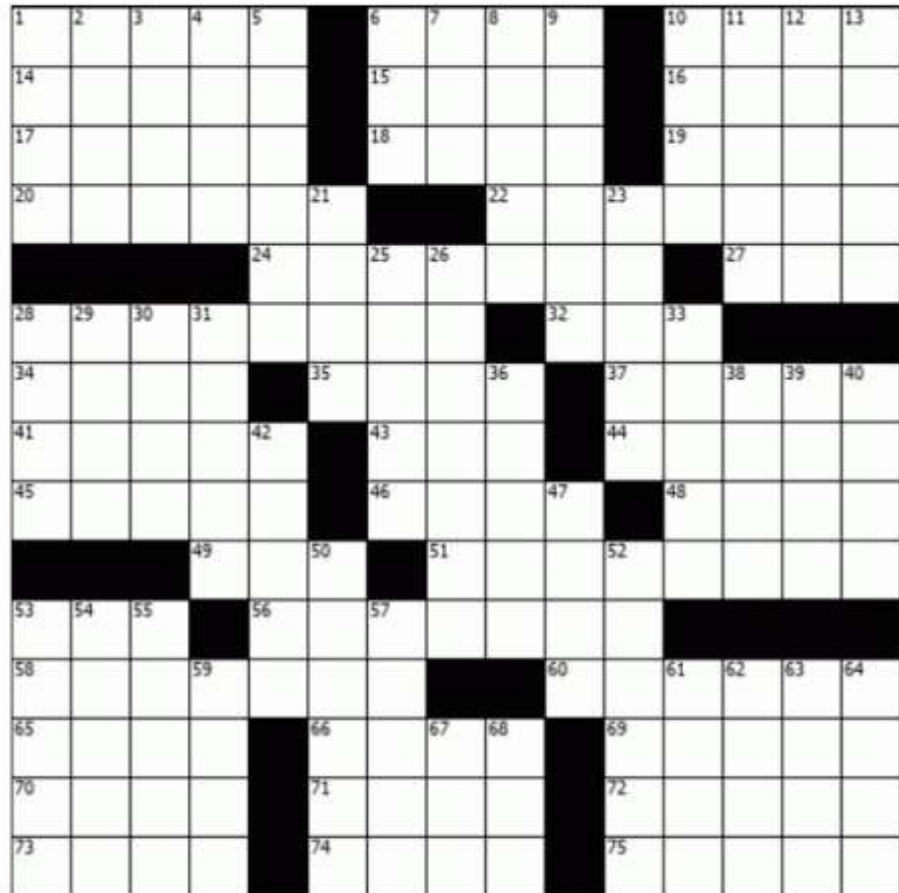
- Preheat oven to 180C. Grease a 3cm-deep, 24cm x 29.5cm (base) lamington pan.
- Process flour, half of the caster sugar and the butter to resemble breadcrumbs. Add 1 egg and vanilla. Process to form a dough.
- Press dough into base of prepared pan. Bake for 15 to 20 minutes, or until light golden. Spread jam over warm base.
- Whisk remaining eggs and remaining caster sugar together. Stir in coconut. Spread over jam. Bake for 25 minutes, or until golden. Cool completely in pan. Cut into pieces. Serve
